Abstract Submission Guidelines

Abstract must be submitted online by the specified deadline.

- Word limit: 300 words (excluding title and author details).
- Clearly state the title, authors, affiliations, and corresponding author's email.
- Abstract must be divided into subheadings of Background, Material and Methods, result and Conclusions with Times New Roman font 12.
- The abstract must be submitted before 1st August 2026.
- Submit your abstract on ispmcon2026@gmail.com
- Specify your preference for oral or poster presentation but it will be finally decided by the committee.
- The e-poster guidelines - it should be 3x2 feet portrait orientation (Vertical).
- **File type:** e-poster should be submitted as a PDF or JPEG file.
- **Size:** The file size should not be more than 10 MB.
- **Orientation:** The poster should be in landscape orientation.
- **Aspect Ratio:** The poster should have a 16:9 aspect ratio.
- **Page size:** The page size should be 10 in wide by 5.625 in high.
- **Font:** The font size should be at least 9 pt. Some recommended fonts include Calibri, Cambria, Arial and Adobe Garamond Pro.
- **Background:** If using dark text, the background should be light, such as white.
- JPG or PNG file with medium or high compression / quality.
- **Text:** The poster should be written in English. The title should be brief and match the abstract.
- **Colours:** Use high-contrast colours, such as light text on a dark background. Avoid using red or green fonts.
- **Slides:** Limit the number of slides to a maximum of 10.
- **Overlapping:** Avoid overlapping objects and layers.
- **Plagiarism:** Any kind of material duplication or plagiarism will lead to disqualification.

Abstract submission

Abstract needs to be submitted online at: ispmcon2026@gmail.com Abstract for the presentation in poster will be submitted to the Secretariat together with duly completed registration form and fees. Abstract will be reviewed and authors will be notified regarding abstract acceptance.

- 1) Standard abbreviations may be used.
- 2) Inclusion of abstract in the scientific program will be considered only after the receipt of registration fees.

The last date of abstract submission is 1st August 2026
